The Department of Homeland Security (the "Department") has completed its review and evaluation of your application relating to Threat Analysis/Security Enhancement Consulting and Engineering/Design Projects (the "Technology"), described in Exhibit A, pursuant to the Support Anti-terrorism by Fostering Effective Technologies Act of 2002, 6 U.S.C. §§ 441–444 (the "SAFETY Act"), and the Regulations Implementing the Support Anti-terrorism by Fostering Effective Technologies Act of 2002, 6 C.F.R. Part 25, 71 Fed. Reg. 33147, 33159 (June 8, 2006) (the "Regulations"). Pursuant to Section 25.3 of the Regulations, the Secretary of Homeland Security has delegated his responsibilities, powers, and functions under the SAFETY Act to the Under Secretary for Science and Technology of the Department.

After thoroughly reviewing the analysis of the Office of SAFETY Act Implementation regarding this application and the Technology, I have determined that the Technology satisfies the criteria set forth in Section 441(b) of the SAFETY Act and the corresponding criteria in Section 25.4(b) of the Regulations. Accordingly, I hereby designate the Technology as a Qualified Anti-Terrorism Technology and issue a Designation (as defined in Section 25.2 of the Regulations) for the Technology to Kroll Security Group, Inc. (KSG), Kroll, Inc., and Marsh & McLennan Companies, Inc. (the "Sellers").
